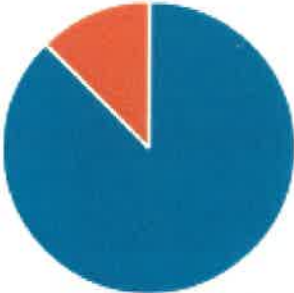

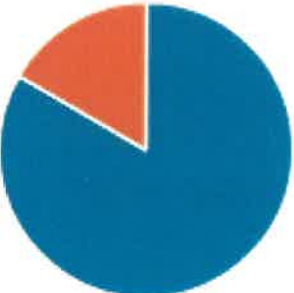
1. Did you know that a change in the law means that all primary schools are required to teach Relationships Education and Health Education? (0 point)

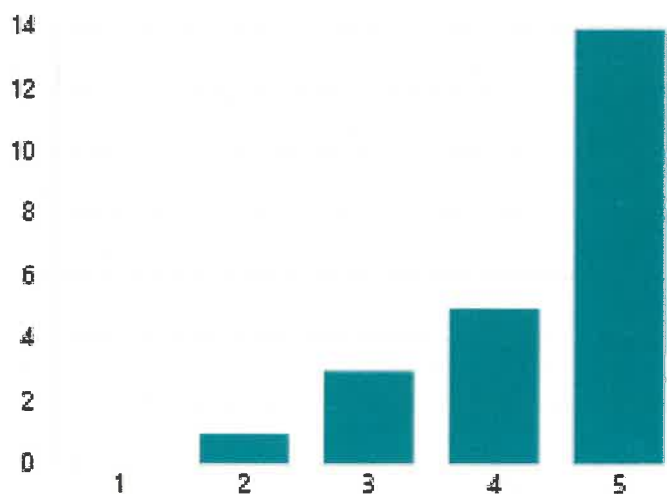
